



#### Moving Forward!

And so we're off! June 10<sup>th</sup> was a glorious day, if you ask me. This church voted to move forward in the following ways:

- Evaluating and restructuring (as needed) our leadership systems;
- Evaluating and restructuring (as needed) our missions and giving systems;
- Renovating our Ground Floor (former youth lounge) room for the use of our church people, with specific attention to our oldest and youngest members.

"That's great!" you say, "What now?" Well, what is now is prayer. Right now, I would ask that each of you begin prayerfully considering what you would like your role to be, what part you would like to play, in moving us forward when we begin these tasks this fall. Would you like to focus more on leadership? Or missions? Or the renovation? We are certainly going to need people to engage in all three, but it would be good if each of you had some idea where you would like to put most of <u>your</u> <u>personal energy</u>. You might be willing to show up to help with a renovation project, but really focus your talents and skills in helping us work on leadership structures. Or, you might really care about missions, and want to be part of setting up that structure, while being content to let others lead on the other two projects.

In September, your current Peakland leadership will each be looking for people to help them in their area. In order to ensure that NO ONE GETS STUCK CARRYING THINGS BY THEMSELVES, we will EACH HAVE TO PICK UP OUR PART OF THE BURDEN. So, this summer, while you're lounging around the pool, or hanging out at the golf course, or sitting on the porch on a lovely Lynchburg summer evening, we're requesting that you begin the work of asking yourself this question: What meaningful work would I like to be part of to help PBC MOVE FORWARD?

### August Community Event

Some members of the PBC leadership have been discussing the possibility of holding a community event this August. At this event, we would invite the larger community (focused on Boonsboro and Rivermont) into our space for a Saturday morning. We have talked about:

- Offering music in our sanctuary, and inviting people to enjoy our beautiful space
- Offering bingo or other games in our Ground Floor Room for those who might not want to be outside
- Building a GIANT SLIP AND SLIDE on our back hill for children, youth, and adults to enjoy
- Having snack foods and drinks-possibly hot dogs-or inviting local food trucks to be here for the day
- Having information about the church available

This would not necessarily be an "evangelical" event—in other words, we are not really looking to gain members. We are more interested in creating goodwill with the community and letting them know we are here. In order to do this, we will need larger buy-in from the church. We will need volunteers in three categories:

- Messaging—creating advertising and signage for the event; preparing brochures or other information about the church to have available on that day;
- Hospitality—preparing the building to receive guests and ensure their safe, happy experience here; preparing and serving food and beverages;
- Activities—preparing the events that would happen both inside and outside the building on that day.

The date we are considering is August 18<sup>th</sup> which is the Saturday after school begins. If you are able and willing to help, send an email to Donna (<u>peaklandbaptistchurch@verizon.net</u>) with your name and the category in which you can offer help.
