- Focus on the significant words from the covenant approved by the entire congregation last year, which expresses our intention to be a


“safe haven for all.”

- What different needs do different people have for safety (for example, those who might need more attention to tripping hazards versus those who might need more attention to language and trauma protection)
- Who are we willing to protect in our spaces? What does it actually look like to say we will protect whoever shows up at our doors?
- How would our church like to live out the call we have put on ourselves to be a “haven?”
- Why is it important to talk about our safety? How are safety and hospitality connected?
